Field Sports Instructor – Morton, IL

Mission

The mission of the Boy Scouts of America is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetime by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law. At Cub Scout Day Camp, you will work with Cub Scouts ages 1st-5th grade to bring them an innovative and rewarding summer program experience.

Job Description

Field Sports Instructors are responsible for the safety and quality of the Field Sports program at Day Camp. Field Sports for Cub Scouts consists of archery, BB guns, and slingshots. Field Sports Instructors oversee set up and tear down of the ranges, maintain all range equipment during the duration of Day Camp, teach and instruct the Scouts through the Field Sports program and uphold the over-all safety of the ranges. Field Sports Instructors report to the Program Director. This is a seasonal job commitment. Day Camp takes place at Dayspring United Methodist Church in East Peoria and Kennel Lake in Morton. The Day Camp runs Monday-Friday through the month of June. There will be set up and tear down required outside of these days. Your hours may shift to cover these times. You will be required to complete additional training online and in person prior to the start of camp.

Principle Responsibilities

- Supervise and maintain the safety of the Scouts in your care.
- Maintain the safety and quality of the ranges and equipment during the camp season.
- Teach and instruct a variety of activities related to Field Sports.
- Follow the rules and regulations of the Camp.
- Implement fun, challenging, age appropriate and rewarding activities for the Scouts.
- Follow the directions of the Program Director and the Camp Director for day to day responsibilities and tasks.
- Make sure the Scouts stay on task, are having fun and being safe with the equipment.
- Provide an unforgettable camp experience for the Scouts.
- Keep high energy and a positive attitude.

Position Requirements

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be a certified BSA Range Master or be willing to get certified.
- Experience working with Cub Scout age youth (1st-5th grade) preferable.
- Register as a member of the Boy Scouts of America as an adult leader and pass a background check.
- Have a basic understanding of the BSA principals and mission and be able to incorporate them into daily activities.
- Have an emphasis on safety, be responsible and have a collaborative attitude.
- Have an interest in field sports.
- Be a positive role model for other staff, parents, and Scouts.
- Be flexible with changing daily assignments and pop-up tasks.
- Have reliable transportation.
